Please forgive me for approaching you on behalf of the Iranian citizen,  
Ms. Mina Khajavi Ghomi.

She has merely exercised her right to freely chose her faith. In June of 2020, she was initially arrested and released from detention after three weeks. Due to alleged endangerment of national security because of advertisement for her Christian faith and the founding of a house church, she was sentenced by the 26<sup>th</sup> Revolutionary Court in Teheran Khajavi in June of 2022 to six years in prison.

Since beginning of the year, the 60-year old has been incarcerated in spite of the fact that she is suffering from a complicated fracture in her foot, which is still festering. The medical care in prison has, so far, been insufficient

According to Article 18 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, which the Islamic Republic of Iran has ratified according to international law, every person has the freedom to change their faith and even to promote it.

Therefore, dear Mr. President, I humbly beseech you to advocate the immediate release without condition of Ms. Mina Khajavi Ghomi.
